GOLF ETIQUETTE

CARE OF THE COURSE: Before leaving a bunker all players must carefully smooth over all holes and footprints. Rakes are to be left in the centre of the bunker parallel to the line of play.

Through the green a player must ensure that any turf, cut or displaced by a player is replaced by sand at once and pressed down, and that any damage to the putting green made by the ball or the player, is carefully repaired.

Players must ensure that when placing down bags or the flagstick, no damage is done to the putting green and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to it, handling the flagstick or in removing the ball from the hole. The flagstick must be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green. Players must not damage the putting green by leaning on their putter, particularly when removing the ball from the hole.

In taking practice swings, players should not cause any damage to the course and tees by removing divots.

It is compulsory to carry and use a sand bucket at all times.

GOLF CARTS: The following conditions apply to all motorised cars:

- Obey all directional signs;
- Keep to pathways where provided;
- Do not drive within five metres of all greens and tees unless on a pathway;
- Two persons only in each cart. Improper use of carts will result in disciplinary action.

Members are asked to pay particular attention to the following paragraphs – observance of them will add to the pleasure on the Course for all concerned.

COURTESY ON THE GOLF COURSE: In the interest and in consideration of all, players must play without delay. No player should play until players in front are out of range.

Players searching for a ball must signal the players behind them to pass as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not be easily found; they should not search for five minutes before doing so; they must not continue to play until players have passed and are out of range. When the play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the green.

BEHAVIOUR DURING PLAY: No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. To speed up play, the honour may be taken by the first player in readiness or it is suggested that shorter hitters may play first, but only when the preceding group is out of range.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE: Maximum number of players in any group shall be four unless directed by the Match Committee. Two-Ball matches have precedence and are entitled to pass any three or four-ball match. A single player has no standing and must give way to a match of any kind.

Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on players in front, it must allow the match following to pass.

HANDICAP AND METHOD OF PLAY

CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

All players are requested to familiarise themselves with the current Conditions of Play.

GENERAL:

STROKE, PAR, STABLEFORD

Full Handicap.

FOURSOMES

Half of Aggregate Stroke Handicap – Players hit off from alternate tees, and then play alternately with one ball.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

3/8ths of Aggregate Stroke Handicap – Both Players play from their tees, select favoured ball, playing alternate strokes until holed out.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

3/8ths of Aggregate Stroke Handicap – Both Players play from their tees, exchange balls and play a further shot before playing alternately with the favoured ball until holed out.

PINEHURST FOURSOMES

3/8ths of Aggregate Stroke Handicap – Both Players play from their tees, play a further shot with their ball before playing alternately with the favoured ball until holed out.

FOUR BALL BETTER BALL

Full Handicap – Stroke play (including both Par and Stableford).

MIXED FOUR BALL MATCH PLAY

Reduce the Handicap of all players by the handicap of the lowest handicapped player who then plays off scratch. Each of the other three players is allowed all of resulting handicap.

IRISH FOUR BALL

Full Handicap – Played in a team of four. The score is the best score by any two of the four in the team.

AMBROSE

Handicaps – After calculations are made (1/8th of the total in 4 Ball and 1/4 of the total in 2 Ball) no teams shall have a handicap higher than the lowest marker in the group. This does not apply to Ambrose "Dropout."

Tee Shots:

Each Player must use at least 6 of their tee shots in 2 ball and 3 in 4 ball. The scorer must record on each hole whose tee shot is used. This does not apply to Ambrose "Dropout."

On the Fairway:

Place a marker within one club length of the chosen ball. Such ball to be played as it lies, other balls may be **placed**, as near as possible to the position from which the ball was marked, (no nearer the hole), any order of play.

Off the Fairway:

Same procedure as above, except, balls other than the chosen ball shall be dropped in the same conditions (no nearer the hole) i.e. hazard, rough, bunker.

On the Putting Green:

The chosen ball **must** be marked. Other balls to be putted within one **putter head length** either side of the chosen ball, no nearer the hole. Any order of play. Do not make tap in putts until all players have had the opportunity to attempt the original putt. Once the ball is holed out, no further strokes are permitted.

FOUR- BALL AMBROSE DROPOUT

All four players make their tee shot. Select the best drive and **mark the ball**. The player who owns the best drive picks up the ball and does NOT play the next shot – the player "drops out" of the next shot. The other 3 players make their shots. Select the best of these. Mark the ball and the owner of the marked ball picks up ball and "drops out" while the other 3 players play the shot. Continue like this until hole completed. Placing or dropping the ball on fairway/green/rough is the same as for Ambrose.

MATCH PLAY

Difference of Stroke Handicap.

FOUR-BALL MATCH PLAY:

Reduce the handicap of all players by the handicap of the lowest handicapped player who will then play off scratch. The other three players are allowed all of the resulting handicap.

CLUB COMPETITION RULES 2016

1. GOLF SERVICES COMMITTEE: *Definition:* The Golf Services Committee means the Golf Services Committee appointed by the Board of Management and will comprise representatives from the Men's Match Committee, Ladies Match Committee and the Course Development Committee.

The Mens and Ladies Match Committees, or their representative, present during the playing of any event, may exercise all the functions of the Match Committee in relation to the event and shall constitute the "Committee" within the Rules of Golf for the purpose of conducting the event.

The Golf Services Committee has control of competition play at all times and reserves the right to alter the programme and method of play at any time.

2. TIME SHEETS: The placement of a competitors name via internet, computer touch screen or hardcopy on the time sheets will be deemed to be officially recognised as "the time laid down by the Committee."

The Golf Services Committee reserves the right to alter any time sheets.

3. OFFICIAL STARTER: Official Starter for all competition events will be the Club Professional and, at times, he may be assisted by additional starters.

Generally, competition play will commence from two (2) tees. Players failing to report to the starter 10 minutes prior to hit off times may be required to go to the end of the field, provided time permits.

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR EVENTS: Apart from the Club fixture events, conditions will be advised on publication of the programme for "Open Tournaments" such as Sapphire Coast Week of Golf, Ace of Clubs, Ladies Open, etc.

Restricted and Recreational Members cannot participate in men's, ladies or mixed honour board events (eg. Club Championships and Foursomes Championships) and Monthly Medals. Members with a current GA handicap and belonging to any other golfing membership categories may participate in and win these events.

Refer to individual conditions of play for 'Annual Events' as listed in the Fixture Book, regarding eligibility to participate.

ALL PLAYERS: All other trophies may be won by visitors with evidence of a current G.A. handicap and paying current green fee and competition fees.

5. HANDICAPS: Daily handicaps will be used for all events unless otherwise stated. Maximum handicaps will be as follows:

Men • Male Members/Visitors with a current GA handicap 36

Ladies • Lady Members/Visitors with current GA handicap 45

All Players – All players other than home club players are required to record their details via touch screen including full name home club golf link number and current handicap, and if a visiting Country Member, they must produce their membership card, otherwise full green fees will be charged.

The Committee in Charge of a competition will require a player to play off the displayed daily handicap.

Handicap Grades: Men are generally:

A Grade 0 to 11

B Grade 12 to 16

C Grade 17 to 21

D Grade 22 to 36

Ladies are generally:

Division 1 0 to 19

Division 2 20 to 27

Division 3 28 to 45

Committee reserves the right to change the Grades for both Men and Ladies at any time. The changes may be due to entry numbers in scheduled event or subsequent handicap changes

All Players – In Four Ball events, the field will be ungraded.

6. ENTRY FEE: Entry fee will be \$12.00 (incl. GST) per player per 18 hole event. This entry fee may be varied when “Special” events are programmed.

7. TIES: Men – In all handicap events other than the Monthly Medals, the winner will be decided using the Golf Australia Countback system.

Ladies – In all handicap events other than the Monthly Medals, the winner will be decided using the Golf Australia Countback system.

8. MONTHLY MEDAL ROUNDS: Men – In the event of a tie in Monthly Medal, the players will play off at the next Monthly Medal round or a date nominated by the Golf Services Committee.

In November 2016, all medal winners will compete for the Medal of Medallist’s trophy. In Stroke events only, Best Scratch will win a voucher.

Ladies – In the event of a tie in a Monthly Medal round, the players will play off in the next Monthly Medal round or a date nominated by the Ladies Match Committee. In October 2016 all monthly medal winners may compete for the Medal of Medallists Trophy.

In all rounds play will be off the current daily handicap.

9. MIXED EVENTS: Mixed Foursomes Championships – best scratch and nett score will be recognised.

10. TROPHIES: Collection – Any trophies or Club Vouchers won in club competitions and not accepted at time of presentation will be lodged at the Club Administration Office and will be available for collection during office hours. If trophies/vouchers are not collected within one (1) month of presentation, they will be forfeited and revert to the Club.

Donated Trophies (Medal Rounds) – Will be awarded for the best eligible Nett score.

BIRDIE HOLE: Men – The Match Committee has decided that it will no longer run a Birdie Hole but will give the balls out as part of the normal ball competition.

Ladies – The Birdie Hole for the day will be displayed on the notice board in the Ladies locker room. This applies to Club Fixture events for Tuesday and Thursday only. (Single events only).

EAGLES: Men – On Par 4 holes only in all competition singles events as per the Fixture Book and Club Championships only. Exceptions to this will be advised.

Ladies – All 18 hole singles events only to qualify.

NEAREST THE PINS: All Nearest the Pin claims must be on the putting surface, the 27th hole for the Ladies is measured on the second shot exception being Open Tournaments. Measurements must be made using the flagstick provided or metal tape measure.

HOLE-IN-ONE: Eligibility in all fixture competitions only. Sponsors Trophy and ball mounted trophy will be awarded to members and visitors possessing a current G.A. handicap. Only members will appear on the Honour Boards.

11. CARDS: Cards must be entered via touch screen and cards returned to the recorder within 10 minutes of the completion of play. All disputes are to be resolved prior to handing in the cards involved.

12. DRESS: Players attention is directed to the Competition Dress Rules displayed throughout the Club.

13. JUNIOR/CADET MEMBERS: In all Club events, without approval from the Committee or Professional, no more than two (2) juniors or one (1) cadet permitted in any group of four players.

14. SLOW PLAY: The low handicapper is responsible for his/her group, but any penalty will be incurred by all players in the group. Players who

fall behind those in front during a competition round and fail to make up the lost ground will incur, after the necessary warning, the appropriate penalties.

Any group failing to maintain their position in the field MUST call the following group through at the first appropriate opportunity.

Penalties – will be in accordance with Rule 6-7: Undue delay – slow play.

15. AUTO LOCOMOTION: Auto locomotion is permitted subject to course conditions for all players and in compliance with the Club's Registration Policy for Carts and Bikes. This condition is for all events unless specifically stated otherwise in the terms and conditions of the event.

16. GOLF CARTS: The following regulations regarding golf cart usage apply at all times:

1. Carts are not to be driven by anyone under 18 years, unless authority has been given by the Club Professional.
2. Two (2) persons only in each cart.
3. Carts are not to be driven within five (5) metres of all greens, tees, bunkers and dams unless on an established pathway.
4. Keep to pathways where provided.
5. Do not leave cart in front of greens when putting out.

Improper use of carts will result in the occupant's disqualification from competition.

17. MOBILE PHONES: Mobile phones are not permitted for personal use during playing and are only permitted for the following use:

- Medical emergencies
- Contacting the Pro Shop or Clubhouse

Penalty: *One warning and then disqualification.*

In Match play the warning may be given by the opponent who may then make a claim in the event of subsequent use.

18. SUSPENSION OR ABANDONMENT OF PLAY:

- Discontinue play for dangerous situations (i.e. immediate suspension) – *One prolonged note of siren*
- Discontinue play for non-dangerous situation – *Three consecutive notes of siren, repeated*
- Resume play – *Two short notes of siren, repeated*

19. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a

stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (eg. gradient, windspeed, temperature etc.), and uses one of these functions, the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 for which the penalty is disqualification.

20. MEN'S ECLECTIC: All single competitions from 5th March, 2016, until 5th November, 2016. Terms and conditions to be advised.
