## From The President

### **DISABLED PARKING**

With increasing pressure on the limited number of disabled parking spaces available adjacent to the entrance to the Club, the Directors have agreed to make their designated parking area available on normal Friday evenings to those members who hold a council disabled parking permit, should the need arise.

Members parking in the Director's area must display their permit on the dashboard of their car in accordance with the normal conditions of the permit.

### **MEMBERSHIP PROMOTION**

Members will be kept informed of progress.
